

2. The Christian Life is a Battle Between Two Natures.


"The old has gone, the new has come"? (2 Cor. 5:17) "Dead to sin"? (Rom. 6)








Why is this crucial for group leaders?

-2 Peter 1:3—




Why is this crucial for group leaders?


- We will be tempted to <u>excuse</u>, dismiss, or <u>succumb</u> to our behaviors.
