#### We are <u>inconsistent</u> for two primary reasons:

We forget about God in the moment

We want to control the outcome



"Trust in the LORD with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; In all your ways submit to him, and he will make your paths straight."

3. The purpose for <u>trials</u> - growth (James 1:2-4)


