WHAT IS A GREAT DISCUSSION TIME?

· A circle of people tossing a frisbee, not gym class volleyball.

WHAT IS THE ROLE OF THE FACILITATOR?

- Bare Minimum: Toss the first frisbee
 - · The Conversation starter, not the conversation maker.

WHY SHOULD WE SHARE THE FACILITATOR ROLE

Sharing Facilitation Destroys Common Myths

- · Facilitation is just for Community Group leaders
- · The facilitator is a fancy word for "this week's teacher"
- · Whoever always dominates conversation should just be the facilitator because they're going to be talking the whole time anyway

Sharing Facilitation Reinforces important Truths

- Group Members:
 - · I am able to spiritually influence others
 - · Without my involvement, this group can't be as effective as it should be
 - · This is a family it's a safe place.
- · Group Leaders:
 - · I am looking for chances to help my people grow spiritually

HOW CAN I SHARE FACILITATION EFFECTIVELY?

- The most important thing you can do is communicate in advance that:
 - WE SHARE ROLES IN THIS GROUP
 - · THIS IS WHEN YOU'RE ON TO DO THIS ROLE
