Cultural Conditions:

- 61% of Americans are lonely.
- 65% of Gen Z sometimes or always feel lonely.
- 27% of Millennials have no close friends.
- George Gallup writes that, “Americans are among the **loneliest people** in the world.”

Spiritual Growth:

- 40% more likely to read their Bibles regularly
- 28% more likely to pray for others regularly
- 25% more likely to confess sin regularly

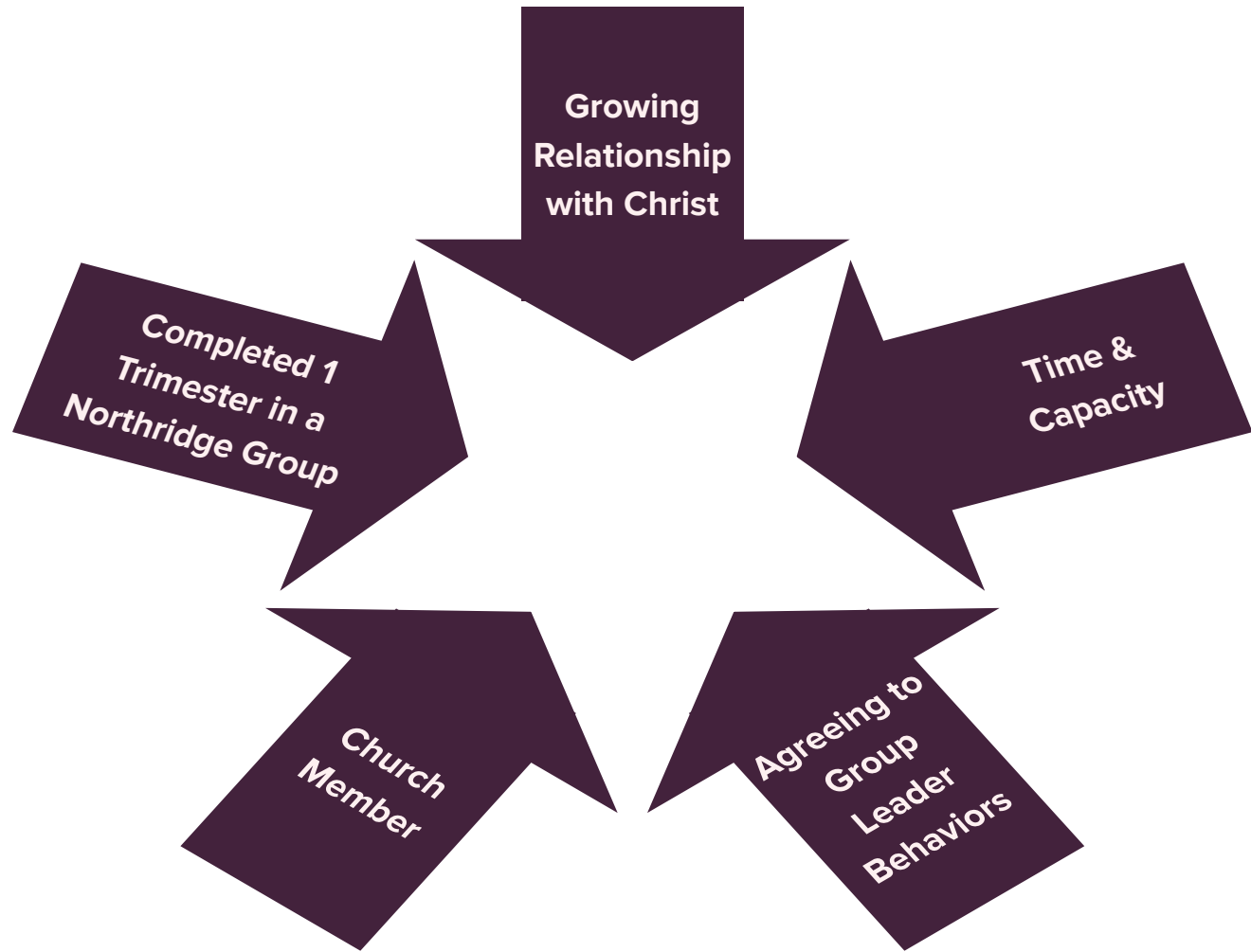

3. Update Online Search Profile
4. Communicate with Group Members
5. Pray for Group Members
6. Raise Up New Leaders
7. Multiply Your Group (On average every 3 years, once you get to 16+ people)
8. Meet with Your Coach (Twice a year)
9. Attend Trainings (Twice a year)
