"Those respondents who attend a group 4 times a month show significantly higher scores in every area of discipleship compared with those who do not attend."

- Transformational Groups

Read Bible +40% (67% vs 27%)

Pray for others +28% (82% vs 54%)

Confess Sins +25% (79% vs 54%)
