## KEEP IT SAFE - CONSIDER THE NEW PERSON

- Don't call on \_\_\_\_\_ to pray.
- Don't expect \_\_\_\_\_ to pray every time.
- Try to avoid praying in a circle.
- Allow members to pray one at a time as they feel led.
- Be clear on who will \_\_\_\_\_ the prayer time.

## 10 CREATIVE IDEAS FOR GROUP PRAYER

1. Prayer through a \_\_\_\_\_ out loud together.
2. When you break for prayer time have spouses pray for each other.
3. Pick a portion of Scripture to pray for one another during the week (for example, Colossians 1:9 or Ephesians 3:14-19).
4. If someone is in \_\_\_\_\_, stop right then and pray for him or her.
5. Share a request and pray for the request.
6. Pray in \_\_\_\_\_.
7. Pray for unbelievers in the lives of your group members.
8. Have someone in your group record the prayer requests/praises and text or email them to the guys/girls.
9. Write requests/praises on a three-by-five-inch card.
10. One sentence prayers.
