ICEBREAKER (5-10 Minutes)

- 1. Share your name and answer one of the following questions:
 - o What is your go-to outfit?

OPENING THE DISCUSSION (5-10 Minutes) – Have someone recap the message in about a minute or two and then ask the following questions:

- 2. What about Jeremy's message stood out to you the most?
- 3. What are forms of legalism you have seen in your own life or culture?

DIGGING DEEPER (10 Minutes) – ask everyone to follow along in their Bible or Bible app. You might consider looking up these passages online and sharing your screen to review them together.

- 4. Read Colossians 2:16-23.
 - **o** How might v16 relate to people pleasing?
- 5. Reread verse 18.
 - o Looking at this verse, what are ways we can get puffed up spiritually?
- 6. Reread verse 19.
 - o How does Paul's metaphor explain the importance of our connection with Christ?
- 7. Reread verses 21-23.
 - o How do rules and regulations have an appearance of wisdom?

APPLYING IT (10-20 Minutes)

- 8. How can you move from trying to look good in the eyes of others into a real connection with the Lord?
- 9. How have you been legalistic in areas of your life? How can you move away from this?
- 10. When have you fallen into being an accuser? How can you move forward?
