

**PLEASE READ BEFORE LEADING DISCUSSION**

- Recommended questions are highlighted in bold, but select 5 or 6 questions you think will work best for your group discussion. You likely won't have time to discuss all of the questions so choose which questions you will ask ahead of time and make sure to provide plenty of time to focus on the application questions.
- Feel free to edit or reword questions to best fit your group.
- You may want to print out copies of this document for everyone so they can follow along with the questions as you read them.

**ICEBREAKER (5-10 Minutes)**

1. Share your name and answer the following question:
  - When is a time in your life you took a risk or did something scary? What happened?

**OPENING THE DISCUSSION (5-10 Minutes)** – Have someone recap the message in about a minute or two and then ask the following questions:

2. Looking at your sermon notes, what statement or question were you most challenged or convicted by?

**DIGGING DEEPER (10 Minutes)** – ask everyone to follow along in their Bible or Bible app. You might consider looking up these passages online and sharing your screen to review them together.

3. Read Matthew 8:23-27.
  - What do you think of Jesus' response to the storm and to His disciples?
  - How does this story impact how you are processing your current circumstances?

**APPLYING IT (10-20 Minutes)**

4. Noah said, "Our greatest fears are the things we find hardest to trust God with."
  - What is hardest for you to trust God with? What are your greatest fears?
5. Noah asked, "If you knew Jesus was coming back in 10 years or even 1 year what would you do today?"
  - How would you answer that question?
6. We are challenging our church to do 4 things as we prepare to launch our Brighton Campus: Give sacrificially, Go to Brighton, Serve the church, Love and Care for our neighbors.
  - What is God calling you to do?
