



Overcoming Spiritual Apathy



#1 - Unconfessed Sin

- When we love our sin, more than we love Christ, we lose intimacy with Christ.
- "See to it, brothers and sisters, that none of you has a sinful, unbelieving heart that turns away from the living God." - Hebrews 3:12
- "If I had cherished sin in my heart, the Lord would not have listened." Psalm 66:18
- "Create in me a pure heart, O God, and renew a steadfast spirit within me. Do not cast me from your presence or take your Holy Spirit from me." - Psalm 51:10-11
- "Search me, God, and know my heart; test me and know my anxious thoughts. See if there is any offensive way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting." - Psalm 139:23-24

#2 - Broken Relationships

- "if you are offering your gift at the altar and there remember that your brother or sister has something against you, leave your gift there in front of the altar. First go and be reconciled to them; then come and offer your gift." - Matt. 5:23-24

#3 - Broken Cisterns
