ICEBREAKER (5-10 Minutes)

- 1. Share your name and answer the following question:
 - When have you had a difficult time waiting for something to be finalized or confirmed?
 - o What is the longest thing you've ever waited for?

OPENING THE DISCUSSION (5-10 Minutes)

- 2. What statement or idea did you find most insightful or challenging from Sunday's sermon?
- 3. According to the sermon, why was it so important that Jesus rose from the dead? What difference did it make?

DIGGING DEEPER (10 Minutes)

- 4. Read Colossians 1:22.
 - Reflecting on this verse, how might Jesus' sacrificial death impact our current choices and how we deal with our past?
- 5. Read Romans 1:1-4. According to verse 4, Jesus' resurrection ratified (or confirmed) He was God.
 - Has it been easy or hard for you to believe the resurrection and how has that impacted your personal faith?
- 6. Read 1 Peter 2:9.
 - O What words or statements in this verse stand out to you?
 - How do we declare the praises of Jesus? What should that look like in day-to-day life?

APPLYING IT (10-20 Minutes)

- 7. Drew shared that Jesus's death and resurrection should lead us to be grateful for what we don't deserve, and to have a passion for those who are far from God.
 - What is one thing you can do regularly to develop a heart of gratitude for what Christ has done for you?
 - Who do you know who doesn't follow Jesus and what can you do this week to share Jesus with them?
