ICEBREAKER (5-10 Minutes)

- 1. Share your name and answer the following question:
 - What prompts do you use most often to give you reminders? (Examples: post-it notes, alarm clock, calendar, phone apps, signs, clothing)

OPENING THE DISCUSSION (5-10 Minutes)

2. What most challenged or inspired you from Sunday's message?

DIGGING DEEPER (10 Minutes)

- 3. Read Joshua 4:1-7. God used stones as both a reminder of His faithfulness and to inspire future obedience.
 - What people, places, or events has God used to remind you of His faithfulness?
 - o Who or what has God used to prompt you toward obedience?
- 4. What are some helpful reminders we can setup today to inspire future obedience in our life and future generations?

APPLYING IT (10-20 Minutes)

- 5. Drew shared in his message that "The church thrives when we are contributors, not consumers."
 - o Where do you need to contribute to helping build the church?
- 6. Drew challenged us to "Be obedient, even if it scares you."
 - Where is God prompting you to obey that you are scared to follow?
