

Please Read Before Leading Discussion

- **Recommended questions are highlighted in bold, but select 5 or 6 questions you think will work best for your group and discussion.** You likely won't have time to discuss all of the questions so choose which questions you will ask ahead of time.
- Feel free to edit or reword questions to best fit your group.
- You may want to print out copies of this document for everyone so they can follow along with the questions as you read them.

POSSIBLE ICEBREAKERS (5-10 Minutes)

(Keep it short. Longer than 10 minutes isn't an ice-breaker – it's a conversation.)

- **Share your name and answer the following icebreaker:**
 - If you could only eat the same meal the rest of your life, what would it be?

OPENING THE DISCUSSION (5-10 Minutes)

(As people share, utilize follow-up questions to keep the discussion as natural as possible: Tell me more, what do mean by that?, Anyone else?)

- **What was your biggest takeaway from Sunday's message? A thought, principle, idea, question, quote, etc.**

DIGGING DEEPER (10-15 Minutes)

(Be sure to manage your time so you can get to "Applying It".)

- **Read Colossians 1:15-23**
 - **What stands out to you from these verses?**
- Read Hebrews 1:3. Drew shared that "All that God is, Jesus is."
 - What might be some of the ramifications for our lives if we don't understand this?
- **Drew shared that "Everything created on earth points to the nature of God."**
 - **What things has God created that best helps you to see the nature of God?**
 - Where is your favorite place to go to observe all that God has created?
- Drew shared that "Where you build your foundation determines how long you will stand."
 - What are some things you have built your life around that have been unstable?
- Drew shared that "Our lives fall apart if Jesus is not at the center."
 - What does a life with Jesus at the center look like?

APPLYING IT (10-20 Minutes) (You may want to discuss these in prayer time)

- **Drew shared 3 ways to make Jesus supreme in your life:**
 1. **Identify those areas you have been keeping from God**
 2. **Allow God's word to be the final authority in your life**
 3. **Choose obedience over convenience**
 - **What is an area in your life you have been keeping from God?**
 - **What do you need to do to obey God in that area rather than do what is convenient?**
