ICEBREAKER (5-10 Minutes)

- 1. Share your name and answer the following question:
 - What is something you are looking forward to this summer?

OPENING THE DISCUSSION (5-10 Minutes) – Have someone recap the message in about a minute or two and then ask the following questions:

- 2. If you could summarize Sunday's message, what would you say was the most important point?
- 3. What questions did this sermon raise for you?
- 4. John Calvin said, "Without knowledge of self, there is no knowledge of God."
 - How does an accurate view of ourselves help us when we read about God in Revelation?

DIGGING DEEPER (10 Minutes) – ask everyone to follow along in their Bible or Bible app. You might consider looking up these passages online and sharing your screen to review them together.

- 5. Read Revelation 8:6-9:21. Look for themes or patterns as you read this passage about God's judgement.
 - o What stands out to you in this passage?
 - o What themes do you notice about God's judgment?
- 6. Reread Revelation 9:1-6.
 - o In this passage, those who rejected God just wanted that judgement to end. In what ways do those who reject God today try to escape God's judgement?
- 7. Reread Revelation 9:20-21.
 - What keeps people from turning away from sin and toward God when faced with His judgement?
- 8. Read Revelation 11:3-14.
 - God used 2 witnesses to speak the truth of God in a world that rejected God.
 What can we learn from their example?

APPLYING IT (10-20 Minutes)

- 9. How does message change how you view God and yourself?
- 10. What was your biggest takeaway from this message?
- 11. How are you progressing in the growth goal you set at the beginning of the trimester? What goals do you want to set for this summer?
